I (Bruce Green) enlisted a new speaker. I approached our Inspector General Sharon Schulte about doing a presentation in regards to the estimator's role in assisting with the IG's office in fraud investigations and generally how the estimating/engineering side is a resource for the IG. She is interested and said she would be glad to do it. I will get more details later on the specifics.

Also, we have a major bridge project in the St Louis area I would like to have our resident engineer and/or the prime contractor on these projects do a presentation. It is a \$78 million PCC segmental box bridge and, from what I understand, is one of a handful of this type built in the US. I will find out next Tuesday on this. Another potential agenda item I am pursuing is a open forum discussion on exactly where in a DOT organization does the preparation of the Engineer's (letting) estimate belong. We are surveying other states currently due to some senior level internal discussion in our agency. Our out of state travel is being cut drastically in MO, so I am not sure how many people we will be allowed to bring this year.
